Music Therapy Tip: A Cabasa?





The cabasa, or "sound brush" as some of the kids know it, is a wonderful sensory instrument. Its roots stem from being a Latin percussion instrument, holding the handle and using the other hand to push the beads back and forth in a consistent, rhythmic pattern. The cabasa has been used in music therapy as a sensory instrument that the kids cannot get enough of! Whether it's helping with motor skills by using one or two hands at a time, sensory stimulation by playing it on their arms and legs, or just jamming along to a song, the cabasa / sound brush is a fan favorite among many!
