Music Therapy Tip: The Theremin



MusicWorks started to use the Theremin in our small group music therapy sessions. Originally invented by a Russian physicist around 1920 and later patented in 1928, the Theremin is one of the earliest types of electronic instruments. The unique aspect of the Theremin is that it does not need to be touched to be played. The player simply moves their hands and arms above and next to two antennas located on each end of the controller to make music. These musical properties of the Theremin are precisely why they work so well for the clients at MusicWorks. Children and adults with sensory integration challenges can play the instrument without having to touch it, and they can maintain full control of volume and pitch at the same time. Additionally, it can be used to create a variety of "sound effects" and different sounding music. This is a unique and recent addition to our choices of instruments that we offer at MusicWorks.
